

4-year-old program:

Focuses on developmentally appropriate activities that encourage the child's desire to learn. Beginning writing, letter recognition, and letter sounds through hands-on activities encourage individual learning and help prepare children for Kindergarten readiness.

This program is available either three (3) or four (4) days per week.



Young 3's:

Focuses on activities to enhance social and emotional development in an easy-going, fun environment. It is an excellent introductory to school for these little ones. Through play they will learn the importance of sharing, listening, and cooperating with others. It is a 1½ hour class that meets two (2) times per week January-May.


Pre-K program:

Focuses on preparing children for Kindergarten. Teachers offer activities in beginning reading, writing, and letter/sound recognition and activities to enhance critical thinking in areas of math and science. This program meets five (5) days per week.

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The Bartlett Park District Preschool program is a recreation based, DCFS licensed preschool with many educational elements. It has been in existence for over 25 years.

The program follows the U-46 school calendar. Preschool is held at the Bartlett Community Center, 700 S. Bartlett Road, in the six classroom Preschool Wing designed specifically for preschool aged children.

Ages:

A September 1st birthdate is used for the three and four year old programs and a January 1st birthdate is used for the Young 3's and Pre-K programs. All children must be toilet independent to participate in preschool.

Preschool fees are for the entire school term September through May.

*Young 3's Program is January-May. A payment plan is available through your checking account or credit card or full payments can be made with check, cash, or credit card.

3-year-old program:

Focuses on large motor, fine motor, social and emotional skills. Cognitive development is enhanced through beginning math, science and letter recognition activities. Teachers create an environment that encourages learning through play while fostering independence. The program meets two (2) or three (3) days a week for two hours.
