



BARTLETT PARK DISTRICT SPRAY PLAYGROUND RULES

Leiseberg Park and Blue Heron Park

**Hours of Operation: Memorial Day to Labor Day
Daily from 11am to 7pm**

**The following rules have been established to promote
the safe and enjoyable use of the Spray Playground.**

Supervision/Use:

- The Spray Playground is unsupervised; use at your own risk
- Children under the age of 9 years must be supervised by an adult (16 years or older)
- One adult for every three children recommended
- Persons having contagious diseases or infectious conditions should not use the Spray Playground

Dress Requirements:

- Only bare feet or aqua socks; no street shoes
- Only clean swim apparel may be worn
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear disposable swim diapers with tight fitting plastic pants over them

The Following Are Prohibited:

- Running, rough play, or climbing on equipment
- Food, beverages, glass containers
- Soaps, shampoos, conditioners, or body washes
- Spitting, spouting, or drinking of water
- In-line skates, skateboards, or bikes
- Smoking or alcohol
- Pets

Spray Playground Closings:

- When thunder or lightning is heard or seen; participants should seek shelter and wait 30 minutes after the last thunder or lightning is seen before returning to the Spray Playground
- Park maintenance, special events, or other reason determined necessary by the Park District
