A variety of animals consisting mainly of reptiles, amphibians, and insects are available for viewing.

Displays of animal bones and pelts are also on display. In the summer a natural butterfly garden is planted in front of the Visitor Center.



## Scheduling Programs

- All programs are scheduled on a first come-first served basis.
- Programs can be scheduled during regular business hours, evenings and weekends.
- Dress for the weather; many programs have an outdoor segment, barring weather extremes.
- Programs will be held rain or shine unless cancelled by the Park District.
  - Room rental payment due upon reservation.
- All programs need to be paid at the time of booking.
- All bookings need to be made 1 month in advance.

## Scout Programs

The Bartlett Nature Center offers a variety of Cub Scout and Girl Scout programming. Advance register is required for Scout Saturdays.

## Bartlett Nature Center

The Bartlett Nature Center provides unique, fun and customized educational opportunities for all ages. The Bartlett Park District began offering nature classes in 1999 and added a nature classroom above the Schrade Gymnasium. With the expansion of the nature programs, an intergovernmental agreement was reached in 2006 to move the Bartlett Nature Center out to the James "Pate" Philip Visitor Center within the State Park.



## Trails & Activities

### Trails and activities at James "Pate" Philip State Park

There are four miles of crushed limestone trails on 501 acres. Hiking, bicycling, cross country skiing, and snowshoeing are permitted on trails. A trail from the parking lot connects to the Illinois Prairie Path, and Fox River Trail. When snow is on the ground snowshoes are available for rent through the Nature Center on an individual or family basis. Groups must call and reserve in advance 847-608-3120. Ask a member of the Nature Center Staff for more information. Geo-caching is also a popular activity within the State Park.

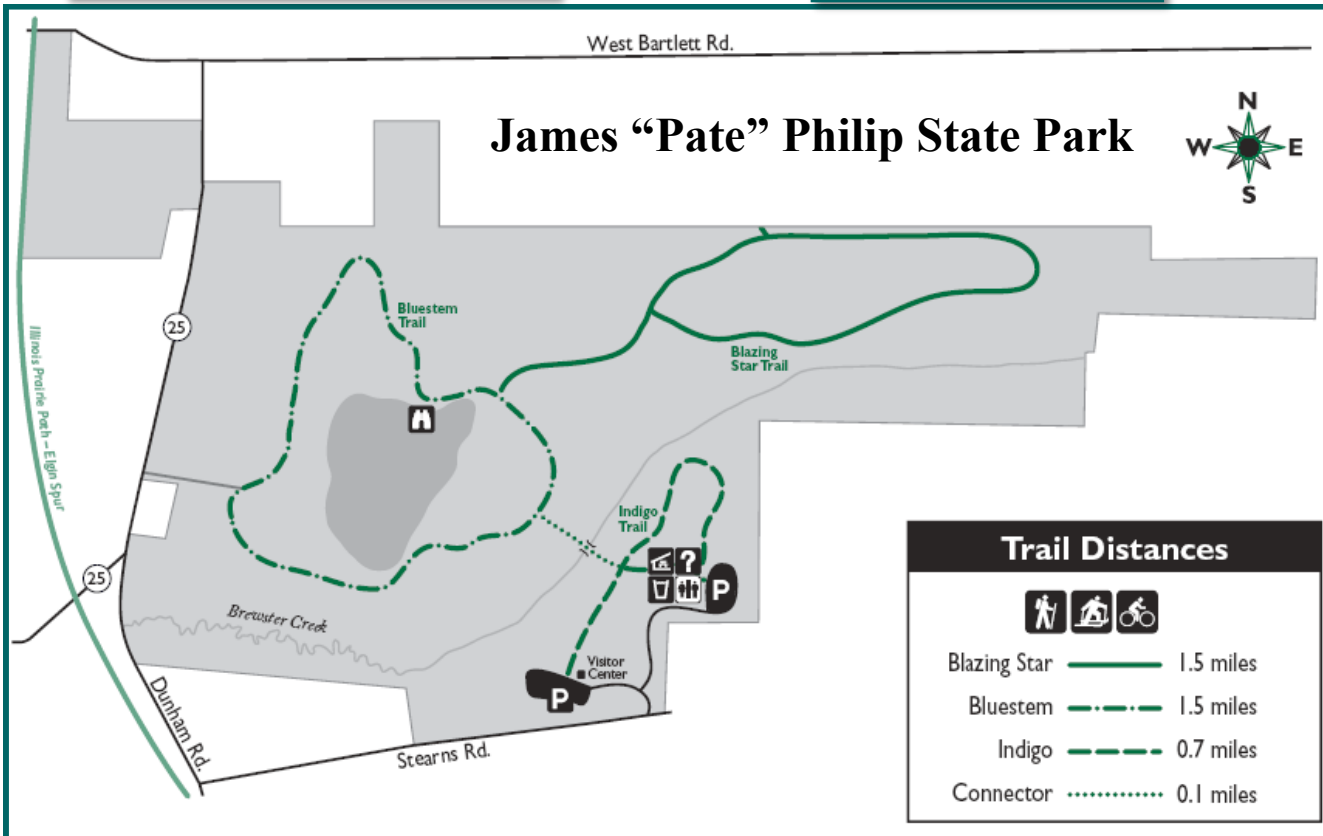
