### **Wetland Wonders**

(Grade Level: Preschool - 8th)

What is a wetland and why are they important? Learn what animals call a wetland home. You can be a good steward in wetland preservation by knowing the importance of water as a valuable resource.

#### **Feathered Friends: Birds**

(Grade Level: Preschool – 8<sup>th</sup>)

Come fly with us as we investigate bird characteristics and habits using hands-on experiences. Discover the unique adaptations birds possess and the various feather types. Students can try their hand at nest building and see if they can migrate safely back home through an interactive game.

## **Tracking Tails**

(Grade Level: Preschool – 3<sup>rd</sup>)

Animals live in the most interesting places. As you hunt for holes, look under logs, and peek at the prairie can you discover whose house you are looking at? What kind of animal left that footprint? Come with us as we discover the wonders of wildlife.

#### **Habitat Hunt Animals and their Habitats**

(Grade Level: Preschool – 8<sup>th</sup>)
Students will find clues that reveal the four components of all habitats and how they are important to the survival of living things. Participants will learn concepts in understanding how plants and animals are interconnected.

#### Sun and Seeds

(Grade Level: Preschool - 3rd)

Do you know that you actually eat roots, stems, and flowers? Discover the four basic needs of a plant and plant your own seeds to take home!

## **Pee Wee Paleontologist**

(Grade Level: Preschool – 3<sup>rd</sup>) Children will become Pee Wee

Paleontologist. The earth has changed a lot since dinosaurs have roam the earth. We will explore the Jurassic age. Learn about dinosaurs and fossil and things in between.

(Grade Level: Preschool – 8<sup>th</sup>)

#### **Insect Safari**
