



Bartlett Community Center Gymnasium Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Am I allowed to have food/non-alcoholic drinks in the gym?

A: No. Food is NOT allowed in the gym. If you are having a social function in the gym, food will only be allowed in the Oak Room (Which also has to be rented). Beverages other than water are also not allowed in the gym.

Q: Are street shoes allowed in the gym for social functions/dances?

A: No. In order to protect the flooring in the gym, street shoes are not allowed. Renters and their guests must remove their shoes before entering the gym.

Q: Is alcohol allowed in the Gym?

A: No. The Oak Room is the only facility in which alcohol is allowed.

Q: What other special rules apply to social functions/dances taking place in the gym?

A: 1. A higher security deposit per court may be required, based on the size and nature of the rental.

2. A higher gym rental fee will be charged if the rental runs after the normal business hours of the
Community Center.

3. Any and all musical and other equipment that is brought into the gym must also have a protective tarp underneath it to protect the gym floor.

4. No tape or tacks may be used on the gym walls or floor.
