

**BARTLETT PARK DISTRICT
COMMITTEE WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2019**

Call to Order

President Eckelberry called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Roll Call

President Eckelberry called for roll. Commissioners answering present were: Stephen M. Eckelberry, Diana Gunsteen, Theodore J. Lewis, Susan M. Stocks, Dale Ann Kasuba and Jody Fagan. Commissioner Lori Palmer was absent.

Staff members present were: Executive Director, Rita Fletcher; Superintendent of Recreation, Kimberly Dasbach; Superintendent of Villa Olivia, Peter Pope; Superintendent of Parks and Planning, Kelly O'Brien, Superintendent of Business Services, Kevin Romejko; and Superintendent of Special Facilities, Lynsey Heathcote.

Pledge of Allegiance

President Eckelberry led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Finance Committee, Ms. Gunsteen, Chairperson

Ordinance 19-06 – Authorizing Supplemental Property Tax Levy

Ms. Gunsteen asked Mr. Romejko to speak about the supplemental tax levy. Mr. Romejko stated that this inaugural ordinance was prepared in conjunction with Speer Financial and Chapman & Cutler Bond Counsel, which allows the District to capture any increase in debt service extension base relating to the payment of debt service on the 2018 Bonds during tax year 2019. For 2019, the District's DESB has grown by 1.9% and this supplemental levy ordinance allows the District to capture this increase for the payment of debt service on the 2018 bonds. Staff is requesting Finance Committee approval of Ordinance 19-06, Authorizing a Supplemental Property Tax Levy to Pay the Principal of and Interest on Outstanding Limited Bonds for the District. Mr. Eckelberry made a motion to approve the levy as presented, seconded by Ms. Stocks. **Motion Carried.**

Resolution 19-07, Estimate of Taxes To Be Levied

Ms. Gunsteen asked Mr. Romejko to speak about the estimate of taxes. Mr. Romejko stated this is an annual item that is required by the Truth in Taxation Law. Based on state statute at least 20 days prior to the adopting the Tax Levy Ordinance the Board of Commissioners must meet and formally determine the estimated amount of money to be levied in 2019 and extended in 2020. The proposed levy does not exceed 105% of the prior year levy, therefore no public hearing is required. Staff is requesting approval of Resolution 19-07, Estimate of Taxes To Be Levied. Mr. Eckelberry made a motion to approve the Resolution as presented, seconded by Mr. Lewis. **Motion Carried.**

Playground Equipment Purchase

Mr. Eckelberry reported the Board selected playground equipment in August for Bartlett Park. To secure 2019 pricing the playground manufacturer is requesting an approved

purchase order before the end of the calendar year. The equipment will be stored at the manufacturer's warehouse until spring of 2020. Staff is requesting approval to purchase playground equipment from BCI Burke Company for the amount of \$166,453.66. Mr. Lewis made a motion to approve the request, seconded by Ms. Stocks. **Motion Carried.**

Program Guide Bid

Ms. Kasuba informed the board that on Friday October 25th a bid opening was held for the Park District program guide. Three bids were received and references were checked on the lowest bidder and they all came back favorable. Staff is requesting the bid be awarded to Paulson Press for the amount of \$124,500.00 which is for three years of program guides. Mr. Lewis made a motion to hire Paulson Press, seconded by Ms. Stocks. **Motion Carried**

With over 95 performers it's a great show and everyone is encouraged to attend the show which starts on Friday December 6th and goes through December 14th.
