Coronavirus Update: March 21, 2020

The Bartlett Park District has been monitoring the Coronavirus health concern. Based on the rapidly evolving situation and acting on Executive Order 2020-10 issued by the Governor of the State of Illinois the Bartlett Park District is canceling all programs, closing all facilities, golf courses, athletic fields, the skate park, and playgrounds through Tuesday, April 7th.

Bartlett Park District programs, activities, and public access will be suspended at the following locations:

Bartlett Community Center (including **LIFECENTER** Health & Fitness Club, Splash Central, Party Place, and the Oak Room), Schrade Gymnasium, Bartlett Nature Center, Villa Olivia, Log Cabin in Bartlett Park, Apple Orchard Golf Course, Villa Olivia Golf Course, T.C. White Administration Building and the Parks Department Building.

Public Access to facilities, athletic fields, the skate park, playgrounds, and programs is tentatively scheduled to resume on Wednesday, April 8th. Bartlett Park District outdoor trails remain open.

During this closure fulltime staff will be available to the public via email during normal business hours. Extra measures are being taken during the closure to do deep cleaning.

Spring Athletic Leagues are currently postponed more information will be coming.
