



BARTLETT PARK DISTRICT SPLASH PAD RULES

Leiseberg Park and Blue Heron Park

Daily from 11am to 7pm

The following rules have been established to promote the safe and enjoyable use of the Splash Pad.

Supervision/Use:

- The Splash Pad is unsupervised; use at your own risk
- Children under the age of 9 years must be supervised by an adult (16 years or older)
- One adult for every three children recommended
- Persons having contagious diseases or infectious conditions should not use the Splash Pad

Dress Requirements:

- Only bare feet or aqua socks; no street shoes
- Only clean swim apparel may be worn
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear disposable swim diapers with tight fitting plastic pants over them

The Following Are Prohibited:

- Running, rough play, or climbing on equipment
- Food, beverages, glass containers
- Soaps, shampoos, conditioners, or body washes
- Spitting, spouting, or drinking of water
- In-line skates, skateboards, or bikes
- Smoking or alcohol
- Pets

Splash Pad Closings:

- When thunder or lightning is heard or seen; participants should seek shelter and wait 30 minutes after the last thunder or lightning is seen before returning to the Splash Pad
- Park maintenance, special events, or other reason determined necessary by the park district
